TITLE: DIRECTORIES FOR APARTMENT AND

**CONDOMINIUM COMPLEXES** 

## **PURPOSE:**

To provide standards for installation of the above.

**REFERENCE:** 2021 IFC 505.3 as amended and Henderson Development Code 19.9.9

## **RULES & REGULATIONS:**

When required by the Fire Code, an approved permanent directory shall be provided.

- I. A directory may be required at complexes of more than two buildings, meeting any of the following circumstances:
  - A. The complex that has a range address example, 100-200 Lake Mead Drive
  - B. The complex has a single address for several buildings.
  - C. The front setback for any building which is not visible from both directions on the addressed street.
  - D. The side of the building facing the street from which it is addressed is not visible from both directions.
  - E. Buildings within a complex are addressed off of two or more streets.
  - F. As determined by the *Fire Code Official*, when unique complex layouts present a hazard to life and property.
- II. Submit a site plan showing directory locations and provide detailed shop drawings of all directories for review and approval prior to installation. All proposed graphics and text shall be at a readable scale.
  - A. Minimum specifications for all directories:
    - 1. A directory shall be placed at each entry to a complex
    - 2. The directory shall be of sufficient size to allow all information, verbiage, and numbering to be easily read from the fire lane.
    - 3. The directory shall be internally or externally illuminated so as to be visible and readable at night.
    - 4. The directory shall identify all: buildings, apartments or space numbers.

- 5. The directory shall be designed to show buildings, apartments, or spaces in relation to streets, drives or walkways they are serviced by.
- 6. The owners or management group shall supply copies of the directory to the Fire Department on paper of sufficient size to be easily readably, but in no case less than 8½" by 11" paper.
- 7. In addition to the information contained on the directories the printed copies shall also contain the locations of all: key boxes, fire alarm control panels, fire department connections and fire hydrants, provided for the protection of the complex.
- 8. The owners or management group shall maintain the directory and update it whenever additions or alterations change the design of the complex; an updated copy shall be submitted to the Fire Department on paper of sufficient size to be easily readably, but in no case less than 8½" by 11" paper.
