The program will take place Monday-Friday in afternoons between 3:00pm-6:00pm aligned with the school calendars. Beginning on May 27th, Academic Enrichment Specialists will serve at Battle Born Kids Summer Camp at various Parks and Recreation venues. Programming includes homework help, mentoring, social emotional skill-building, and engaging STEM and Literacy activities at each site in multipurpose rooms and outdoor spaces.
