April is National Fair Housing Month. The City of Henderson celebrates the passage of the federal Fair Housing Act in 1968, which prohibits discrimination in the sale or rental of housing based on race, color, national origin, religion, sex (including sexual orientation and gender identity), familial status, or disability. Silver State Fair Housing Council (SSFHC) is contracted by the City to provide information about equal housing rights.
