- **PAYMENTS:** Once the participant is enrolled with a deposit for a particular week(s), a weekly payment must be made to complete the registration and maintain their spot in the program. Payment in full is required on or before the Wednesday prior to each week the child is scheduled to participate. The Wednesday deadline time depends on the payment method you choose:
 - ✓ Online registration at <u>Cityofhenderson.com/parks</u>: 11:59 p.m. (Please note online registration function on our website may not work properly on some mobile devices. If you wish to register online, please use a desktop or laptop computer. Online Help Contact: (702)267-4122)
 - ✓ **Any recreation center:** (hours or operation may vary by location)
 - ✓ We understand that children may come from a situation where parents are separated, divorced, or currently seeking a divorce. However, if an account is left unpaid, the child will not be allowed to participate in the program, regardless of which parent is responsible for paying the balance.
- ➤ <u>LATE FEES</u>: A \$10 late pick-up fee will be charged for every 10-minute increment a child stays past the scheduled program time, starting at 6:01pm. The late fee is due before the participant returns to the program.
 - ✓ If the child is not picked up 30 minutes after site closing time, the proper authorities will be notified.
- **ABSENTEEISM/SUSPENSION:** No credit will be given when a participant is absent or suspended.
- MEDICATION: If your child takes medication &/or is taking medication during their stay, you will need to complete a medication release form. Medication must be in its original container with the pharmacist's label. Label must display child's name, the name of medication, the instructions/dosage, and the name of the prescribing physician. Only a daily dose should be in the medication container and parents MUST pick up the empty container each day.
 - ✓ Liquid medication must be premeasured with the above information attached.
 - ✓ If the child is taking other medication, please still complete the medication release and supplemental form.
 - ✓ <u>Asthma inhalers and epi-pens</u> must be brought by a parent to the program site and must be accompanied by a copy of the prescription. Participant must carry the fast-acting medication be capable of self-administering the medication should the need arise. Please be aware that staff members are not required to administer any fast-acting medication for any participant.
- ➤ PERSONAL ITEMS: We ask that children please leave all toys (cards, footballs, etc.) and electronics (iPods, cells phones, video games) at home. Please ask your child to check our lost and found box which is located in the Lobby for any misplaced items. THE CITY OF HENDERSON IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR LOST OR STOLEN ITEMS.
- ➤ BREAKFAST & LUNCH: The City of Henderson at Henderson Multigenerational Center will have a no charge meal program for participants every weekday. The monthly menu is available at the front desk for your convenience. Participants may bring their own food for the program if they desire. Please do not send anything containing Peanuts.
 - **✓** BREAKFAST: Breakfast is not provided.
 - ✓ <u>LUNCH</u>: Lunch will be served from 11:30am-1:15pm (based on group and swimming).
 - ✓ <u>SNACK:</u> Snack is provided by our summer meal program, but it is highly recommended that you send extra snacks with your child.
 - ✓ We do have vending machines, but they do not supply nutritional foods. If you do provide your child with money for the vending machines, no large bills; the front desk cannot make change. Children are responsible for their own money and the use of the vending machines is at their own risk.
 - ✓ Please note, we cannot refrigerate or microwave lunches or snacks.
- ➤ DRESSING FOR PROGRAMS: Our program involves active play. Please have your child dress in play clothes (halter and tube tops not allowed). For safety purposes, skate shoes or open toed/heeled shoes are not permitted. Tennis shoes are strongly recommended. Dress policy applies to all daily activities, field trips, swim days, and special events. Shorts must be between mid-thigh and knee- length and fit properly. If your child is inappropriately dressed for the program, we will call and ask you or your emergency contact to pick up the child or bring the appropriate clothing needed.
