Field Trips

You must sign in your child one (1) hour prior to field trip departure times; thirty (30) minutes on swim days.

SWIM DAYS @ Black Mountain Activity Pool

Groups 1, 2, 3 Thursdays, 9am-11am Groups 4, 5, 6 Tuesdays, 9am-11am ALL SWIMMERS MUST ARRIVE BY 8:30AM TO ATTEND SWIMMING.

Wear your swimsuit, bring a backpack with towel, sunscreen & change of clothes!

Parent Reminders:

- <u>PAYMENTS</u>: Once the participant is enrolled with a deposit of 10% for a particular week, a weekly payment must be made to complete the registration and maintain their spot in the program. Payment in full is required by 11:59pm the Wednesday prior to each week the child is scheduled to participate.
 - Online registration: Cityofhenderson.com/parks (Please note online registration function on our website may not
 work properly on some mobile devices. If you wish to register online, please use a desktop or laptop computer.

 - At any recreation center: Hours of operation may vary by location.
 - Late payment policy: Results in loss of deposit(s) and your spot(s). Please check with the individual facilities for availability. If space becomes available, the full weekly payment will be required.
- <u>LATE FEES</u>: A \$10 late pick-up fee will be charged for every 10-minute increment a child stays past the scheduled program time, starting at 6:01pm. The late fee is due before the participant returns to the program.
 - o If the child is not picked up 30 minutes after site closing time, the proper authorities will be notified.
- <u>ABSENTEEISM/SUSPENSION:</u> No credit will be given when a participant is absent or suspended.
- <u>MEDICATION</u>: If your child takes medication &/or is taking medication during their stay, you will need to complete a medication release form. Medication must be in its original container with the pharmacist's label. Label must display child's name, the name of medication, the instructions/dosage, and the name of the prescribing physician. Only a daily dose should be in the medication container and parents MUST pick up the empty container each day.
 - o Liquid medication must be premeasured with the above information attached.
 - o If the child is taking other medication, please still complete the medication release and supplemental form.
 - O Asthma inhalers and EpiPens must be brought by a parent to the program site and must be accompanied by a copy of the prescription. Participant must carry the fast-acting medication be capable of self-administering the medication should the need arise. Please be aware that staff members are not required to administer any fast-acting medication for any participant.
- <u>PERSONAL ITEMS:</u> We ask that children please leave all toys (cards, footballs, etc.) and electronics (iPods, cells phones, video games) at home. Please ask your child to check our lost and found box which is in the Lobby for any misplaced items. THE CITY OF HENDERSON IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR LOST OR STOLEN ITEMS.
- <u>SUMMER FOOD PROGRAM:</u> The program at Black Mountain Recreation Center will have a no charge meal program for participants every weekday. The monthly menu is available at the front desk for your convenience. Participants may bring their own food for the program if they desire. Please do not send anything containing peanuts.
 - O <u>BREAKFAST:</u> is not being provided by Three Square in favor of afternoon snack.

<u>LUNCH:</u> Lunch will be served 11am-12pm

- o SNACK: 2pm-3pm
- We do have vending machines, but they do not supply nutritional foods. If you do provide your child with money for the vending machines, no large bills; the front desk cannot make change. Children are responsible for their own money and the use of the vending machines is at their own risk. Trips to vending machine will be limited to snack time.
- Please note, we cannot refrigerate or microwave lunches or snacks.
- <u>DRESSING FOR PROGRAMS:</u> Our program involves active play. Please have your child dress in play clothes (halter, crop and tube tops not allowed). For safety purposes, skate shoes or open toed/heeled shoes are not permitted. Tennis shoes are strongly recommended. Dress policy applies to all daily activities, field trips, swim days, and special events. Shorts must be between mid-thigh and knee-length and fit properly. If your child is inappropriately dressed for the program, we will call and ask you or your emergency contact to pick up the child or bring the appropriate clothing needed.
