How Do You GET Public Water Supply Information for Fire Sprinkler Design, Without Leaving Your Office?



There is a new procedure in place for pulling an F-206 permit by using your fax machine & computer. See the attached procedure for instructions on how to apply for this permit. Two pieces of paper, 15 minutes of your time, \$153 permit fee and you're done.

No sending crews out to meet a fire inspector, no opening a fire hydrant, no spending hours in researching which water zone you need, no coming to Henderson City Hall. The results are e-mailed right back to your office. The normal turnaround time for processing this request is 2 weeks.

Manual flow test are still allowed see City of Henderson Ordinance 2889, 2009 IFC Section 507.4, "When approved, a manual water supply test may be permitted." Note: Manual flow test permits are required for private waterlines as they are not modeled by the City of Henderson.
