City of Henderson Community Preferences

- Regional Priority during Southern Nevada Strong
 - More than 70,000 participants
 - Henderson residents ranked education as #1 priority
- Henderson Strong Comprehensive Plan
 - Reached more than 26,000 residents
 - Schools and Education ranked among the top-three community priorities in all zip codes by an average of 25% more respondents than any other choice.



- 6 High Schools









Enrollment






Proficiency Rates




Graduation Rate

Note: For the purposes of this analysis, large school districts are defined as those with at least 25,000 students enrolled across all levels of instruction: 304 districts meet this criteria.


Smarter Balanced Assessment Consortium




SBAC Student Growth
