Part. 1 Applicant's Responsibility	Applicants are responsible for ensuring applications submitted are complete. Incomplete applications will not be accepted. City service commitments will not apply to incomplete submissions.			
Part. 2 Prerequisites	<b>Application Readability</b> . Easily Read; legible; a readable typeface. Vivid contrast or difference in brightness between the light and dark areas of the drawing.			
Part. 3 Applicable Codes	Application must meet the requirements of the Henderson Municipal Code 15.32 as adopted.

		1.	Site Plan A detailed site plan of entire area, including fall out zone.	
		2.	Notification Plan - Notification of the fireworks display must be provided(mailed) not more than 30 days and not less than ten (10) days prior to the fireworks display, to all occupancies and residences as specified in the permit. A copy of the notification plan shall be included with the permit application.	
Part. 6 Other Information				
	1.	Overtime Fees Displays not scheduled during normal working hours will require overtime fees.		
	2.	Maximum Displays Fireworks displays shall not exceed eight times per calendar year in any one location. Any exceptions to this requirement must be approved by the Fire Marshal, or designee.
