\*\*The dissimilarity index (D) measures whether one particular group is distributed across geographies in the same way as another group. A high value indicates that the two groups tend to live in different areas. D ranges from 0 to 100 percent. A value of 60 (or above) is considered very high. It means that 60% (or more) of the members of one group would need to move to a different tract in order for the two groups to be equally distributed. Values of 40 or 50 are usually considered a moderate level of segregation, and values of 30 or below are considered to be fairly low.
